

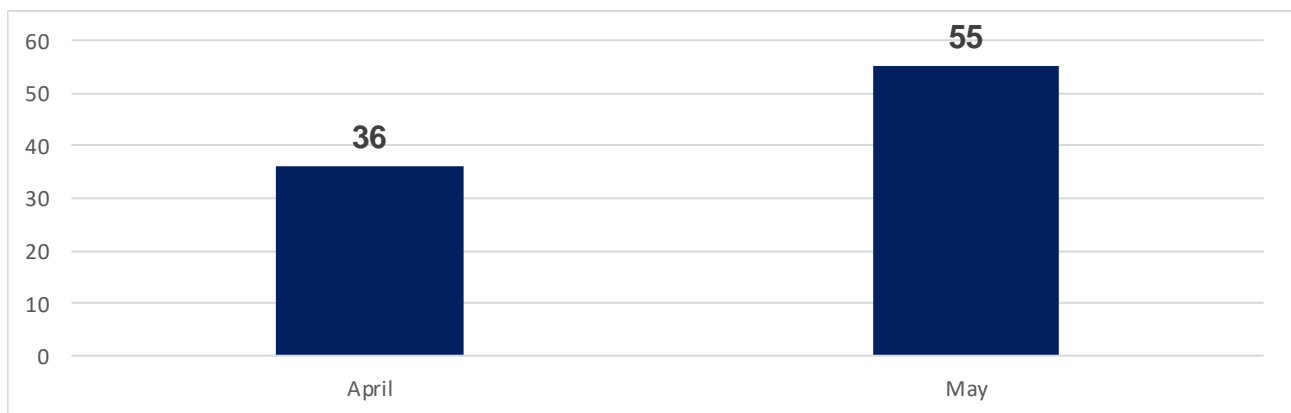


## **Suspected Non-Fatal Opioid Overdose Report: Ward 1**

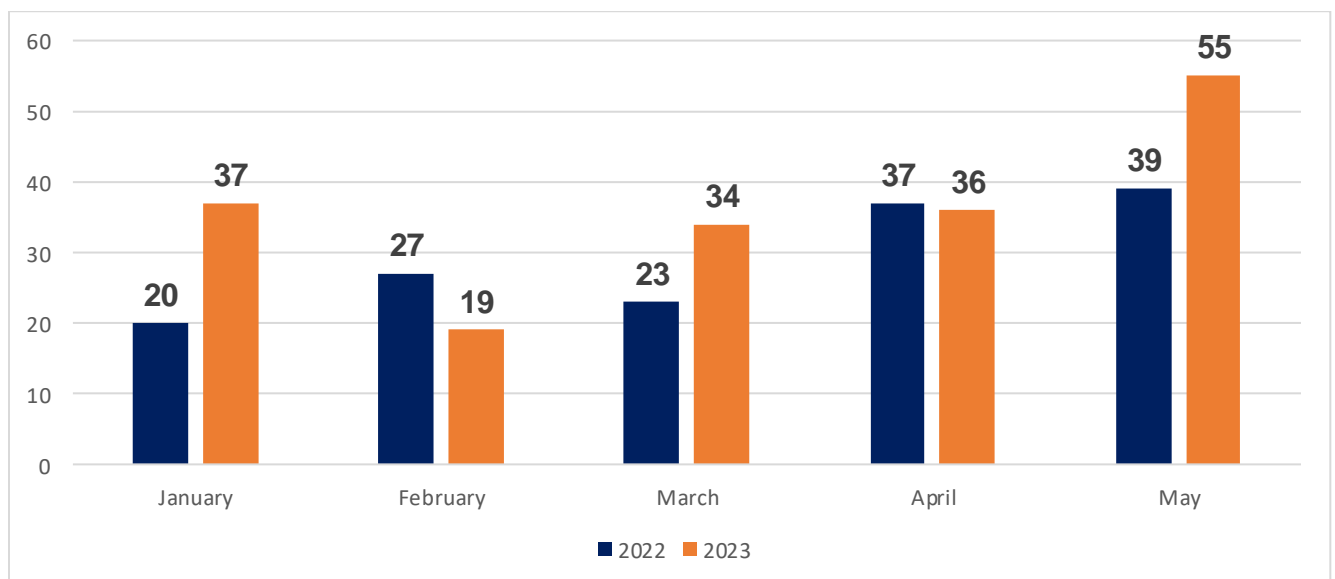
**April - May 2023**

A total of **91** non-fatal opioid overdose cases were reported in Ward 1 between April 2023 and May 2023. These suspected cases were reported and obtained from the District of Columbia Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department (FEMS) non-fatal opioid overdose data\*.

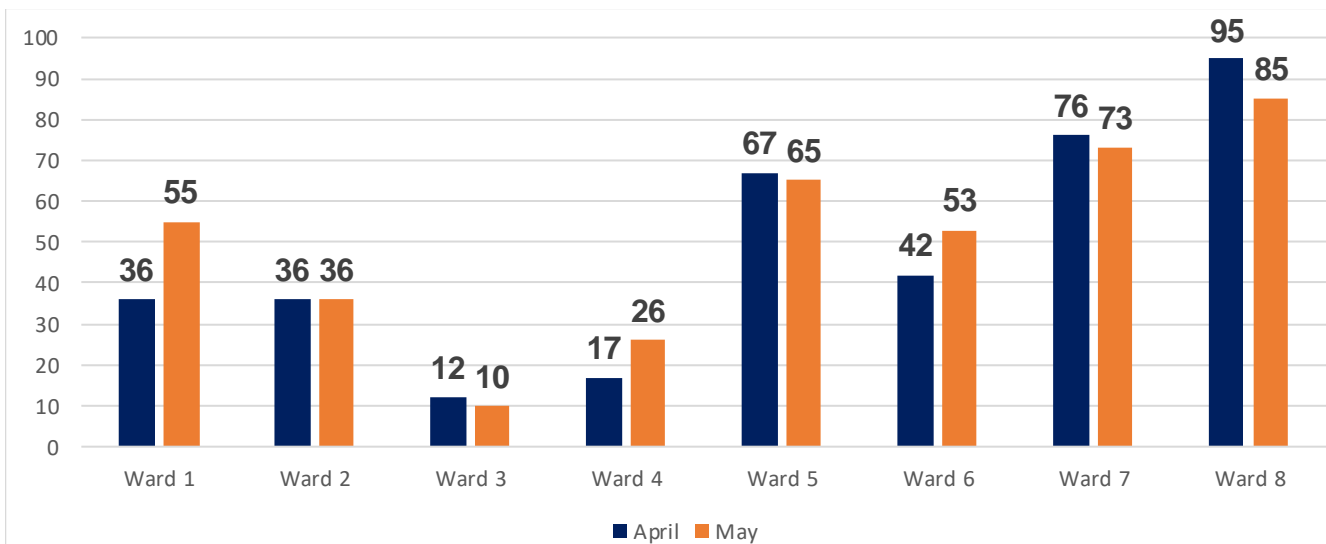

## **Non-Fatal Opioid Overdoses in Ward 1: Jan. – May 2022 vs. Jan -May. 2023**



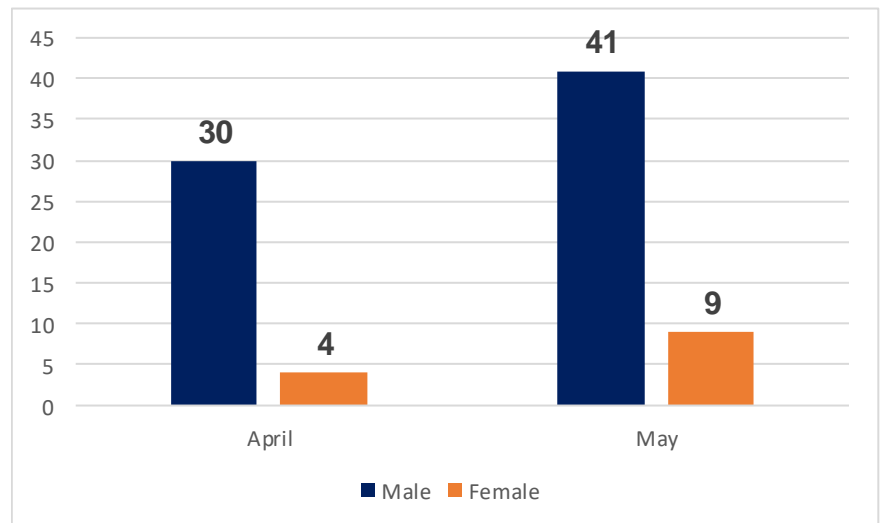
### Non-Fatal Opioid Overdoses by Wards of Residence: April -May 2023



### Demographics

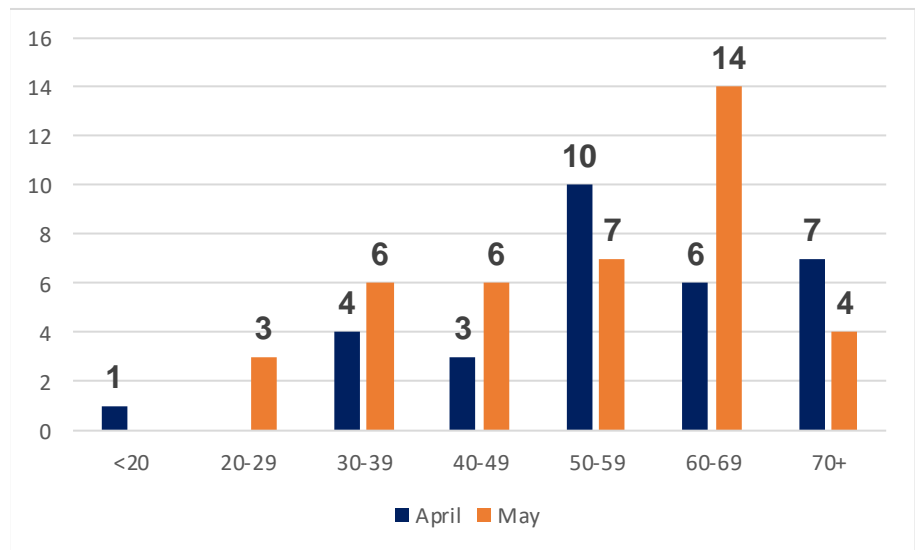
#### Gender

Between April and May 2023, **males** had the highest number of non-fatal opioid overdoses in Ward 1, representing approximately **85%** of all non-fatal overdoses.



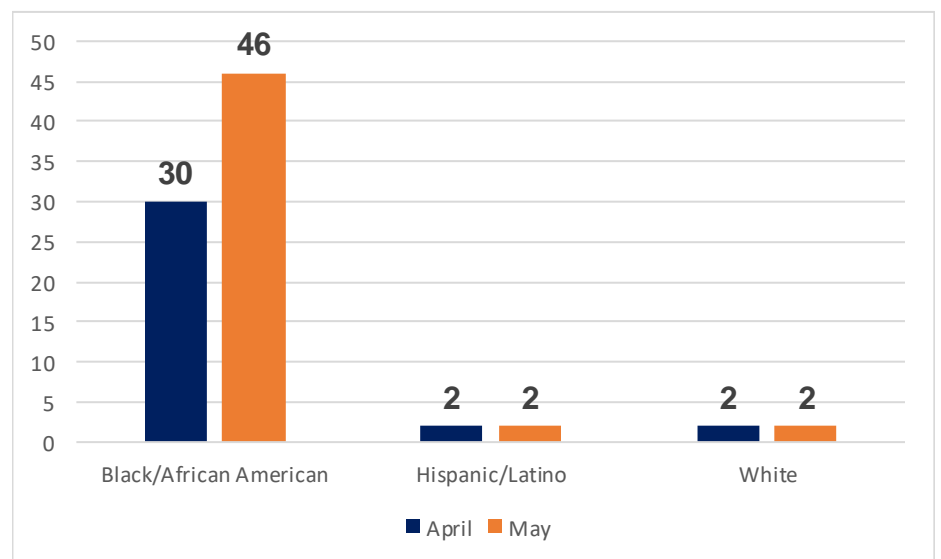
### Age group

Between April and May 2023, the number of non-fatal opioid overdoses was highest among people aged **50-69**, representing approximately **52%** of all non-fatal overdoses in Ward 1.



### Race/Ethnicity

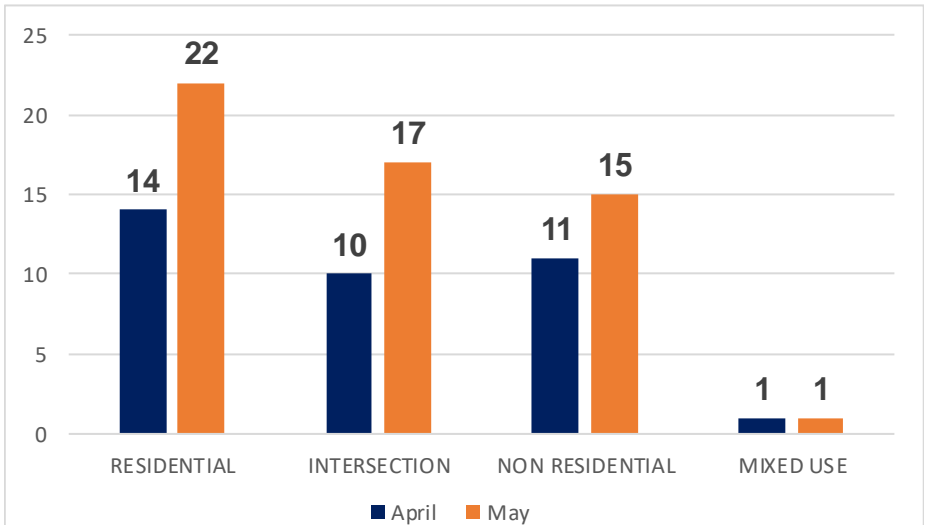
Between April and May 2023, the number of non-fatal opioid overdoses was highest among **Blacks/African Americans**, representing approximately **90%** of all non-fatal overdoses.



## Non-Fatal Opioid Overdoses by Residential Types\* in Ward 1

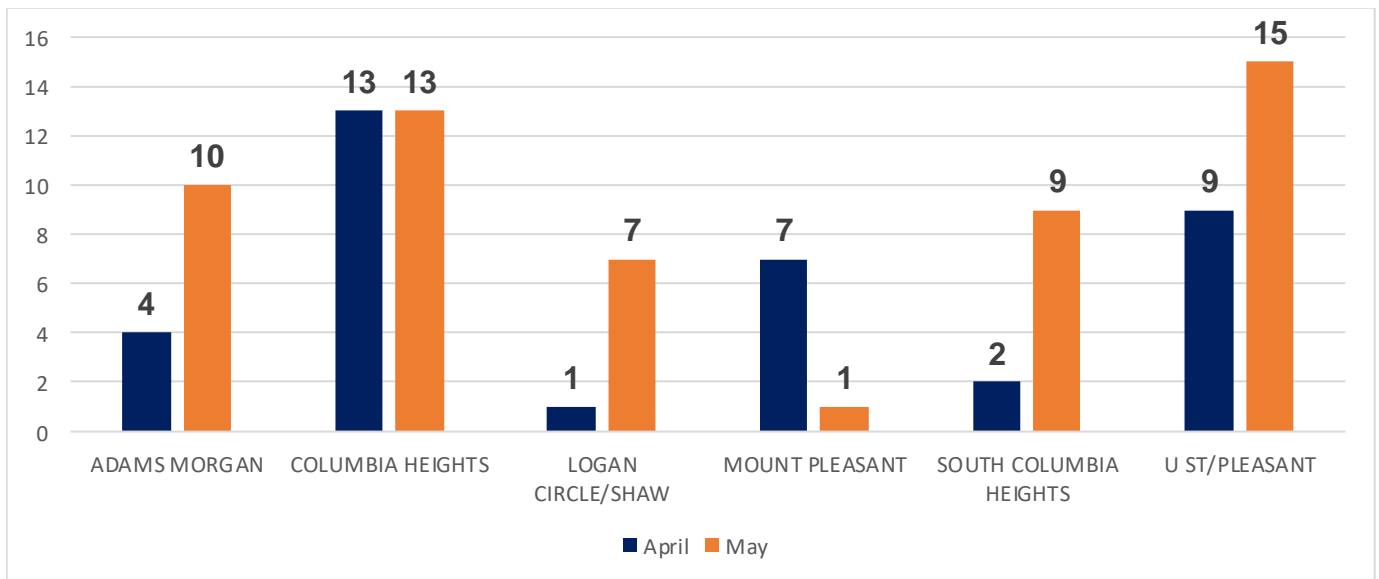
Between April and May 2023, most **(40%)** non-fatal opioid overdoses in Ward 1 occurred in **residential sites**.

## Non-Fatal Opioid Overdoses by Neighborhoods\* in Ward 1

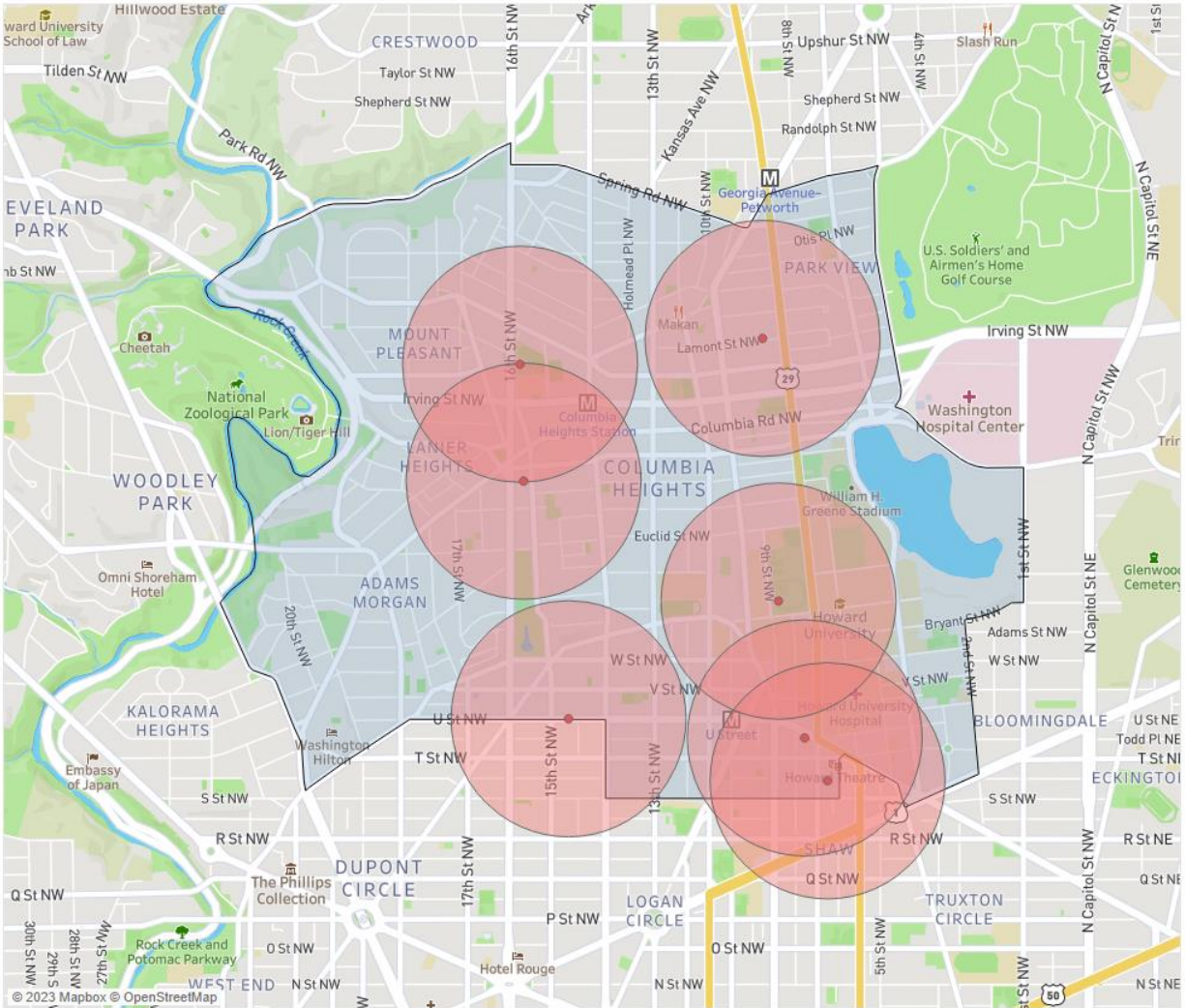

Between April and May 2023, **Columbia Heights** and **U ST/Pleasant** were the top two neighborhoods with non-fatal opioid overdoses representing approximately **29%** and **26%** of all non-fatal opioid overdoses in Ward 1.

## Hot Spot Locations

At least 5 cases of **non-fatal opioid overdose** occurred **within 0.3 miles** of the following locations.



- Of the 91 non-fatal opioid overdose cases between April and May 2023, **16 (approx. 18%) overdosed in their homes.**
- Of the 91 non-fatal opioid overdose cases between April and March 2023, **18 reside in Ward 1 (approx. 20%).**
