




Total Number of Opioid Overdoses by Year



Total Number of Opioid Overdoses by Month and Year (n=1144)




Number of Opioid Overdoses Containing Fentanyl/Fentanyl Analogs by Quarter, 2015-2019




Opioid Overdoses by Most Prevalent Age Category




Opioid Overdoses by Race




Opioid Overdoses by Gender




Race of Decedents by Age Group




Percent Breakdown of Residence by Year




Opioid Overdoses by Ward of Residence and Year




Percent Change of Drug Overdoses due to Opioid Use by Ward and Year




Percent of Drug Overdoses due to Opioid Use by Age Range and Year (DC Residents Only)
